The Sloths and Cheetahs are learning all about pronouns (I, me, you, him, her, he, she, they, them, we, us, it), when to use each one, and what types of words they replace. We'll delve into possessive, indefinite, and reflexive pronouns next week.

Spelling superstars! The Cheetahs and Sloths got right back into the groove of spelling, both with classwork and homework. Graded tests will be sent home early next week. Due to back-to-back 4 day weeks, our sensational spellers will practice our next set of words for two weeks. More information will be shared via email next week.

Peppy puppeteers! The Sloths and Cheetahs are busy writing scripts and rehearsing for the upcoming puppet shows in JK. They are learning so much about how to collaborate and delegate responsibility, while also enhancing their oral fluency and storytelling skills!
