Everyone's favorite Golden Ticket raffle is back once again, and this year it has an extra special purpose. Only 200 Golden Tickets will be sold at \$50. Half of the proceeds from the ticket sales (total is dependent upon how many are sold) will be split between 6 winners:

- 1 Grand Prize Winner will receive 25% of the proceeds (up to \$2,500)
- 5 additional winners will receive 5% of the proceeds each (up to \$500 for each winner)

We're excited to share that 50% of this year, those funds will be used to transform the upstairs teachers' lounge space into a renovated Teachers' Wellness Room!
