Winter 2025 Archangel Clubs

Math

Mrs. Parker's class continued the unit of measurement. This week we compared length using customary units. We used inches, feet, centimeters, and yards to compare and measure objects.

Mrs. Bryan's class continued with our measurements unit as well some spiral math review of what we have already learned thus far.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

In Mrs. Parker's class, we read the book called <u>Each Kindness</u>. This story is a story about the meaning of friendship and kindness.

In grammar, we focused on subject-verb agreement.

In writing, we focused on writing personal narratives. We started our Valentine's Day personal narratives about a time we felt loved. We will finish them next week.

We have continued our novel study on <u>The Mouse and the Motorcycle</u> by Beverly Cleary. We have been analyzing the characters and focusing on comprehension strategies.

In Mrs. Bryan's class, we are continuing to work on our classroom read-aloud *Willowdeen* by Katherine Applegate. Students are working on descriptive writing, what quotations look like and when to use in reading/writing, as well what it looks like to highlight a quote from a chapter.

We also continued our read aloud for Black History Month, *Ranger in Time Long Road to Freedom* by Kate Messner.

We read *The Snowglobe Family* by Jane O' Connor. We worked on our writing assignment in class: A Day In a Snow Globe. Most students choose to write about our recent snow day!

We have also enjoyed a few Valentine's writing assignments in class.

Theology

This week we focused on our expectations and how we will host our second mass on February 18th.

Social Studies

Mrs. Bryan's class was able to continue working on our President's research papers. Mrs. Parker's class will continue to work on them next week. Our snow days and Teacher Work day gave us quite the short week!
