## **Social Studies**

This week in SS, we finished our unit on the American Revolution! Students were able to participate in a project in which they wrote a letter to King George III addressing the Intolerable Acts. They also had to decide between being a Patriot or Loyalist. This was a very engaging activity in which students researched and wrote compelling letters!

Next week, we will begin to look at life in Virginia post American Revolution.

## Science

This week in Science the students enjoyed our continued learning about ecosystems. We began Chapter 6- "Energy Transfer in Ecosystems". We were engaged in an introduction to food chains, food webs, energy pyramids, and the interconnected relationship of producers and different kinds of consumers. Next week we will continue studying various roles of living things in their environment, and how they get their energy.

The Chapter 6 Test is scheduled for Tuesday, February 27th.

## Math

This week in Math we've been focused on mixed number and improper fraction representations and operations. We learned how to convert them, add and subtract them, and next week will focus on word problems involving these operations.

# Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students continued our unit in which they are learning how to write their own realistic fiction stories! This week, students learned how to write powerful endings to their stories. I am so proud of the amazing effort that is being put into this work. We also watched the *Because of Winn Dixie* movie.. One final piece of work we did this week was to continue Book Clubs. This is a great opportunity for students to push their reading skills and continue to excel.

Next week, we will dive back into poetry and learn about the Harlem Renaissance and African American inspired poetry.

# Theology

This week in Theology we've been focused on our Eucharistic miracle project. The kids have been working very hard and did some amazing work. We look forward to beginning Unit 3 Lesson 12 next week. We will dive into understanding the beatitudes, and reflect on the path of our Lenten journeys. Great job to our wonderful Mass helpers this week!
