### Social Studies

This week in Social Studies, students completed a project focused on the American Revolution. Students had the choice of either completing a flag/informative essay or a persuasive letter to King George III himself! Students had a wonderful time and worked very hard on this project!

Next week we will begin chapter 6 which focuses on the aftermath of the American Revolution.

### Math

This week in Math, students have learned how to use benchmark fractions to compare and order fractions, generate a common denominator to compare fractions, and have reviewed identifying/creating equivalent fractions and simplest form. We have enjoyed challenging but fun activities to reinforce factors and multiples, and our fraction knowledge.

The Ch. 8 Test is scheduled for Tuesday, February 28th.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in Language Arts, students continued "Because of Winn Dixie" as well as a writing unit in which we focused on how to write realistic fiction stories. Students learned how to write interesting "leads", create a clear setting, and to draft their stories scene by scene. These stories are really coming together and I am blown away by the creativity of our students!

Next week, we will continue with our stories.

#### Religion

In Religion this week we took a quiz over Unit 3 Lesson 11. We had fruitful discussions about what it means to have human dignity and free will. We learned the meaning of true freedom, and what it means to acknowledge the rights and dignity of others who are also made in God's image. The Passion Play is in full swing. We're so proud of the kids for memorizing their lines, learning the songs, and remembering stage directions. It's going to be a great show!

### Science

In Science this week we took our test over Ch. 8- "Earth's Changing Surface". The kids loved learning about different types of fossils, and were able to compare/contrast various landforms. We learned more about the cause of volcanoes and earthquakes, and got to practice our research and independent study skills in preparation for the test.
