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We focused on science this week.

### Math

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We discussed numbers 16 to 19. We also continued to practice counting to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. At this time, the students are now expected to count to 75. The students have also been counting to 100 by 2s, 5s and 10s. We have calendar time during math every day.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

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The students are continuing to practice reading to self and work on writing.
