Dear Parents,

CCS is honored to be able to offer the following scholarships to 5th-8th students:

- The Grace Cullen Cantonwine Memorial Scholarship (*rising 8th grade students*), funded each year by donors, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Cantonwine. This \$500 award is matched by the Knights of Columbus for a total of \$1,000. To qualify for the award, the following criteria must be met:
 - Enrollment at CCS for the upcoming school year and a student at CCS for the previous three academic quarters.
 - Completion of the attached application.
 - Three letters attesting to the student's character. The letters may be written by any adult other than the student's parents who have worked closely with him/her in some capacity.
 - o Completion of an essay on a topic determined by the Scholarship Committee
 - Grade Point Average and citizenship record will be considered
 - At least one of the letters of recommendation must be from a current or former teacher.
- The Dr. Michael Salerno Scholarship (*rising 6th and 7th grade students*), funded by donors, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Palumbo. This scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000, will be awarded based on academic merit, character, active participation in the school and community, and membership in a Catholic parish. In addition, consideration will be given to the difference this scholarship would make on the family's financial burden of paying tuition.

• The Paul Zacharias Memorial Scholarship (rising 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students), funded by the Paul Zacharias Memorial Fund. Mr. Zacharias was a beloved middle school Latin teacher for twelve years at Charlottesville Catholic School. His unexpected passing led the Charlottesville Catholic Community to remember his commitment to students and serving Christ through the establishment of this fund. The "Paul Zacharias Scholarship" in the amount of \$750 will be awarded based on character and service to the community. In addition, consideration will be given to the difference this scholarship would make on the family's financial burden of paying tuition.

Interested students should complete the attached application. The required student essay will be written in school on Tuesday, March 16, 2021 from 3:30-4:30. Parents need to respond to the question at the bottom of the application. All required documents should be returned by Tuesday, March 16, 2021.
