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## **Social Studies**

This week in SS, we learned about what life was like for Americans once the Revolutionary War was over. Students learned about the Articles of Confederation, the creation of the Constitution, and about George Washington as well.

Next week, we will continue this unit and learn about several other historical figures such as James Madison and Thomas Jefferson. <u>Students will also be memorizing the Preamble of the Constitution for this chapter and reciting it from memory the week of March 4.</u> I have put a copy of the Preamble on SS Google Classroom. ## Science

This week in Science, the kids have enjoyed learning about producers, different types of consumers, the niches animals have in their habitats, and about the food chains and food webs of various ecosystems.

We have officially finished the "Life Science" portion of our Science curriculum. Next week we will begin Ch. 7- "The Rock Cycle". We are excited to begin our studies of Earth Science, and will begin by making our own Sedimentary rocks next week!

The Test for Ch. 6 is scheduled for Tuesday, February 27th.

## Math

This week in Math, we learned addition and subtraction strategies for mixed numbers using a bar model and the number line. We practiced these operations in multi-step word problems, and re-visited our 4 step plan when tackling word problems. The kids are adept at converting mixed numbers to improper fractions and vice versa. We took our Unit 10 Test today.

Next week, we will begin Unit 11- "Multiplying Fractions by Whole Numbers".

Our Unit 11 Test is scheduled for Thursday, March 7th.

# Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students dove back into poetry. Students learned about the Harlem Renaissance and prolific poets such as Langston Hughes. We also practiced writing our own poems!

Next week, students will begin a cross curricular research project in which they research a sub topic of the American Revolution.

# Theology

This week in Theology we reflected on our journey through Lent. We reflected on and discussed the things we will be giving up to make more room for Jesus, and the things that we plan to add in to strengthen our relationships with God. We began Unit 3 Lesson 12 and our study of the Beatitudes. We will continue to learn about ways we respond to God's love next week. The kids worked hard to learn scenes 10 and 11 of the Passion Play in rehearsal today. We look forward to our performance on Thursday, March 28th at 9:00 am.
