English Language Arts

This week in grammar we wrapped up adjectives (Study guide in Friday Folder). For reading we finished our whole class novel study, <u>Charlotte's Web.</u> While we have finished the book we are still working through comprehension and our study guides. We continued on with our cursive. For writing we started really focusing on poetry.

Next week we will wrap up our Charlotte's Web study guide. Note the test will be two parts - part one the students will have to describe 4 characters from the book and list 6 major events; part 2 the students will be creating a "graffiti wall" about the book. This test will begin on March 10th so there is plenty of time to study - study guides will come home next week. Adjective study guides came home today in Friday Folders that test will be March 2nd.

Religion

This week we focused on different types of prayer and different ways to pray. We also took some time with Lectio Divina, which is a way to pray using the Bible. The students also did an amazing job with leading the mass this week.

Next week, we will be taking a break from this unit as we start to talk about Lent. We will talk about the three pillars of Lent next week - Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. On Tuesday students will receive the "little purple book" which is a great daily devotional for students to do during lent that involves a short activity for them. On Wednesday Rice Bowls will be going home for your family. I encourage students to make sacrifices in order to earn the Money - we will also be using the CRS (Catholic Relief Services) resources to learn about the people that benefit from this charity.

Math

We have taken a week to reinforce our multiplication facts and explore how division and multiplication are related. We looked at how you can take fact families and create several multiplication and division sentences from those numbers. In addition, we explored how factors, products, dividends, divisors, and quotients were related. We will have our first division quiz next Wednesday on March 2nd that will include multiplication as well. Please continue to encourage your student to review multiplication facts when possible. A basics of division review sheet went home in the Blue folder this week, please encourage the students to complete and review it.
