Math

This week we worked on finding the greatest common factor, reducing fractions to the simplest form, and problem solving with fractions. Next week we will focus on LCM, comparing fractions and writing fractions as decimals.

Science

This week we learned about natural disasters and climate types. Next week we will focus on weather patterns and air pressure.

Social Studies

This week we worked on our Black History Month bannerthat will be due **Tuesday, March 1st.** We also reviewed our study of the Founding of our Nation's Government. The test over this material will be next **Thursday, March 4th**. Our States and Capitals region for the next two weeks is going to be the Southeast.

Language Arts

This week students worked on identifying object nouns in sentences. This is a difficult concept, so we decided to move the quiz on the material to Wednesday, March 2 (direct objects and objects of a preposition). We also focused on identifying the theme in a short story and completed the research for the Black History Month figure. Students also took a test on the spelling/vocabulary words. Next week we will start reading *The Phantom Tollbooth*. This is a challenging and fun book, so we will be reading each chapter twice to uncover the many layers of meaning in the book. We'll also be examining the themes revealed in each chapter as well as the book as a whole. The next set of spelling/vocabulary words will come from *The Phantom Tollbooth*.

Religion

This week we began a Body biography project that illustrates and discusses who we are as children of God. We expected to finish the project by Friday but we will complete it next week in class. The Lent season begins with Ash Wednesday on March 2nd. **Students need to be in formal dress for that day.**
