Reading Practice at Home

Please let your child read a decodable reader (word family focused), or leveled reader book to you each night. We'd also encourage you to read to your child each night as well. The effect size for both is great.

Listen to a story. Read at least one story or fluency passage to an adult each night. Practice reading nonsense words or other cvc words. Practice sight words.

Math Practice at Home

Tell the time on a clock in your house to the hour or half hour. Identify coins and count change. Add or subtract items in your house or while shopping at the store. Group and count objects in your house. Practice reading page numbers.




