### Social Studies

We focused on the parts of the Declaration of Independence. We will be learning about key figures in the colonist rebellions.

#### Math

This week we started our geometry unit. We will be measuring angles and classifying triangles. We will be finding volume using formulas.

\*Students will need to complete (mastery level) Khan Academy *Coordinate Plane, Line Plot and Multiply Decimals* by the end of the 3rd quarter.

\* Please practice the basic multiplication facts at home or in the car coming to and from school. Knowing your multiplication facts is a vital skill that students will be needing for success in math in school and in daily life.

### Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we continued our study of *Love That Dog*. We also had a quiz on run-on sentences and reviewed the new vocabulary/spelling words (related to figurative language). We also held our class-level spelling bee this week, which was exciting! The winners for each of the homerooms will compete in the school-wide bee next Friday.

Next week, we will have a test on the spelling/vocabulary terms, and we will have a test on the content of *Love That Dog*. With the busy Catholic Schools Week schedule and the spelling bee competition this week, we did not have time to start our poetry-writing unit. We will begin that next week. We will also begin reading *Love That Dog* a second time, this time annotating the book and focusing on the figurative language included in the story.

## Religion

This week we had a quiz on the first part of the Nicene Creed and on the structure of the Bible. We also enjoyed learning more about the Catholic Faith during Catholic Schools Week! Next week, we will start a unit on the saints, and we will be learning about the ways in which one is declared a saint, and about some of the lives of the saints.

#### Science

This week students learned how we can better care for our environment. We will continue to find how our actions impact our earth. We will be taking a test on 2/8 over Ch. 10. Please have your student review their study guide to prepare for the test..
