Math

This week we focused on measuring angles, classifying quadrilaterals and triangles, and finding perimeter. Next week we will continue our geometry unit and work on finding volume.

#### Science

This week we created sandstone rocks and epsom salt crystals in our labs and focused on mineral properties and characteristics. Next week we will be learning about fossils and what they tell us about our past.

#### Social Studies

This week students reviewed the Revolutionary War and took our assessment. We will begin our unit on Establishing a Nation next week. We will also begin learning our states and capitals.

#### Language Arts

This week we finished reading *Love That Dog*, and students took a test on the book. We also continued with the poetry-writing portion of this unit, and students had a spelling/vocabulary test on the figurative language. Next week, we will continue to write poetry, and we will have a grammar unit on prepositions. There will be a quiz on prepositions on Thursday. We will also start our second read of *Love That Dog*, focusing on the figurative language that is used in the book.

#### Religion

This week we began our study and a project on the Stations of the Cross. The project will be due **Friday, February 11th**.
