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<u>Important School Announcements</u>

- In JK-5th grade, students may bring Valentines in for a Valentine Exchange next Friday. Teachers will notify you if the exchange is by grade or by class. As far as treats, please refer to the list of approved food items in FACTS; non-food treats are always a great option! Treats that are received will be sent home with students. Because of the sheer volume of treat items that will likely come in for Valentine's Day and likely not in their original packaging, the school nurse will NOT be checking each item. For that reason we will be sending everything home for parents to approve.
- Friday, February 14 will be Valentine's Day TAG Day. We will also wear red that day to celebrate Heart Health Month and Wear Red Day.

Important:

 Students may wear a red shirt/sweatshirt for Wear Red Day; however, they MUST be in their uniform bottom (pants, skirts, or jumpers) and uniform shoes. Legging may ONLY be worn under a jumper (not alone).

- TAG Day items:
 - Allowed-socks, belts, earrings, necklaces, ribbons, bracelets, headbands with stabilized decor
 - Not allowed—hats, sunglasses, wigs, t-shirts, headbands with flying objects, anything flashing
