## Science

From navigation to magic, the Hawks became super scientists as they experimented with Magnets. They had a blast making and testing their very own compasses, planning magnet magic tricks to demonstrate for Junior Kindergarten and Kindergarten, and magnetizing objects made of steel and iron. #DiscoveryLearning

The Hawks combined two passions in the STEM Lab this week..Science and Art! Instead of using a paintbrush, your creative cuties used a magnet to guide a paper clip through paint to make designs! Some of these works of art are very "Pollack-esque," while others trend more Picasso, yet they are all one-of-a-kind! Come check out their marvelous masterpieces on display!

### Math

These sensational subtractors took their skills up a notch with an introduction to three-digit subtraction, including mentally subtracting 100s and 10s from three-digit numbers (examples: 300-200, 440-100, 620-10, 130-30, etc.) The Hawks also revisited regrouping, using the same tried-and-true subtraction strategies: the traditional algorithm, base ten

blocks, drawing, hundreds charts, number lines, decomposing, and/or a combination of strategies. As a reminder, when using the algorithm, we like to use the following rhymes:

- More on the top, don't stop!
- More on the floor, go next door and get some more!
- Numbers the same? Zero's the game!

Fabulous Fluency! Please continue to practice math fact fluency daily by using flash cards, calling out problems, rolling dice, or even using playing cards. Your Sloth or Cheetah is sure to impress!

Your child may access the site for free to complete work that we assign, including new assignments focused on three-digit addition and subtraction.
