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Social Studies

This week in SS, we finished our unit on the American Revolution! Students were able to participate in a project in which they wrote a letter to King George III addressing the Intolerable Acts. They also had to decide between being a Patriot or Loyalist. This was a very engaging activity in which students researched and wrote compelling letters!

The final draft of this letter is due on Tuesday, February 13.

Science

This week in Science we've been learning about renewable and nonrenewable resources, the various ways humans impact an ecosystem, and the ways we can restore ecosystems when they're threatened or damaged. We finished presenting our ecosystem projects and enjoyed creating a display in the hallway. They've been a huge hit! Next week we will finish Ch. 5 and begin Ch. 6- "Energy Transfer in Ecosystems".

Our Ch. 5 Test is scheduled for Tuesday, February 13th.

Math

This week in Math the kids have mastered addition and subtraction of fractions with like-denominators. We learned how to use various fraction models and a number line as tools to show what we know. We took our test over Unit 9. We look forward to learning addition and subtraction strategies with mixed numbers next week in Unit 10.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students continued our unit in which they are learning how to write their own realistic fiction stories! This week, students learned how to write powerful endings to their stories. I am so proud of the amazing effort that is being put into this work. We also finished our mentor text *Because of Winn Dixie*. One final piece of work we did this week was to begin Book Clubs. This is a great opportunity for students to push their reading skills and continue to excel.

Next week, we will watch the *Because of Winn Dixie* movie and finish up our stories.

Theology

This week in Theology we finished Unit 3 Lesson 11. The kids enjoyed learning about Blessed Carlo Acutis last week to kick off our February Tenet of the month- "creators", and in addition to making an inspirational saint card and crafting a short prayer related to his story, have been researching the Eucharistic miracles he featured on his very own website. The kids are working on these projects in groups to create pamphlets and mini-posters showcasing their research on these miraculous events.
