Social Studies

This week students will begin the unit on ancient civilizations. They will be introduced to Ancient Egypt and learn about the contributions to our present day. Students will explore geography, architecture, inventions, and written language.

Next week students will learn how the geography of Ancient Egypt had a big impact on its peoples lives and how Egypt has changed in size over time.

Math

This week students will be introduced to the relationship between multiplication and division. They will learn the meaning and vocabulary associated with the process of division.

Next week students will use strategies such as drawing models, using numbers lines, and repeated subtraction to solve division problems. They will also learn about inverse operations and fact families for multiplication and division.

This Week:

We continued our exploration into Black History Month by featuring prominent and influential african americans in this country into our readings, discussions, and activities. This week, our read aloud highlighted the life of Marian Anderson, one of our country's most important singers and role models. Additionally, we learned how our mentor sentence (book - Sojourner Truth's Step-Stomp Stride), which used lyrical and spiritual text, was an effective piece of writing that displayed how bold and beautiful she was.

Theology

This Week:

We continued focusing our attention on Lent, thus, preparing for the great sacrifice that Jesus will make for us, growing closer to God, and asking him for forgiveness. We completed activities that draw upon the Lenten disciplines of prayer, almsgiving, and fasting/abstinence.

Next Week:

We will be working through our Theology of the Body curriculum (Lesson 3 - Sin Distorts the Gift). Students will learn that sin is a failure to love, will recognize that sin distorts our ability to recognize the gifts of God, and will identify ways to reconcile relationships between people and God. We will also be working in our Christ In Us workbook (Lesson 9 - How do we celebrate God's forgiveness and healing?) - Quiz - Fri 3/8

Science

This week students completed their Google Slides Project on the Solar System and presented it to the class.

Next week students will begin their Matter Unit beginning with solids, liquids and gasses. They will identify the properties of matter and use descriptive words to explain the attributes of each phase.
