Social Studies

This week in SS, students continued to learn about the lives of Americans once the Revolutionary War was over. We focused on James Madison, Thomas Jefferson, and the Bill of Rights!

Next week, we will continue this unit. <u>Students will also be memorizing the Preamble of the Constitution for this chapter and reciting it from memory on Friday, March 8.</u> I have put a copy of the Preamble in the SS Google Classroom. Please reach out if you have any questions.

Science

This week in Science we concluded our study of ecosystems and the Life Science portion of our curriculum. We began Chapter 7- "The Rock Cycle", and are excited to kick off our studies of Earth Science. We learned about sedimentary, igneous, and metamorphic rocks, and how they form. We look forward to learning more about the rock cycle and to making our own rocks.

Math

This week in Math we have been focused on Unit 11. We learned how to multiply fractions by whole numbers. We are continuing to practice modeling this multiplication on a number line, and employing the skill of converting improper fractions to mixed numbers.

Our Unit 11 Test is scheduled for Friday, March 8th.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students began a cross curricular research project in which they researched a sub topic of the American Revolution. This group research project will push students to learn more about the American Revolution and sharpen their critical thinking and research skills.

Next week, we will continue this unit.

Theology

This week in Theology we've been exploring the Beatitudes and the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. We learned about the ways in which our conscience is at work, and about the ways we can incorporate faith, hope and love- the Theological Virtues- in our everyday life. These are the simple ways we can respond to God's love.
