## **Social Studies**

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We will be focusing on the Bill of Rights.

### Math

We will be completing part of our unit on measurement. Students will be using the ladder method for converting metric units. The mnemonic we are using is "King Henry Doesn't Usually Drink Chocolate Milk." Our chapter 12 test will be on Wednesday, March 6th.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (khanacademy.org). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 3rd gtr. requirements, due before the end of the guarter 3/19/24 are Coordinate Plane, Line Plots and Multiplying decimals (under 5th grade - not Getting Ready for 5th).

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week students concluded their second reading of Love That Dog, focusing on figurative language. They also had a spelling/vocabulary test on the figurative language terms. We also read two informational texts, focusing on identifying a main idea and supporting details. We will continue working on this skill next week and have a quiz using this skill on Thursday. We also started working with direct objects and objects of a preposition.

Next week, students will focus on indirect objects and will have a quiz on direct objects, objects of a preposition, and indirect objects on Friday. They will also receive a new set of spelling words, which will be a list of commonly misused homophones. They will have a quiz on those words early the following week.

# Theology

This week we finished our short unit on Lent and the Stations of the Cross with a quiz today.. Next week, we will begin a unit on the structure of the Bible and on the Pentateuch.

# Science

We have started our rock cycle unit. We will be doing several labs during this unit. We will be making epsom salt and borax crystals this week.
