Science

This week students will complete our unit on vertebrates and invertebrates. They will begin working on their science project involving a vertebrate and an invertebrate.

Next week students will complete their project and will be introduced to earth's place in the solar system. They will learn about what causes the seasons, and how the moon interacts with the earth.

Social Studies

This week students will complete their projects and begin their presentations on Monday.

Next week students will be introduced to Ancient China and its contributions, such as written language, architecture, and inventions.

Math

This week students will be introduced to multiplication by using arrays, repeated addition, and be introduced to the commutative property of multiplication.

Next week we will continue to learn strategies and vocabulary for multiplication. They will work on a problem solving investigation activity by using a table to organize the information in the word problem. Students will also have a unit test on Money this week.

We continued our focus around Lent, completed activities that explored the significance of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving during this time, discussed how the church welcomes all of us through The Sacraments of Christian Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation), and learned how the Holy Spirit places a spiritual mark on our souls, connecting us to God forever.

Next Week: As we move into the Fourth week of Lent, we will watch videos, read/discuss from our workbook, and complete activities that help us to build our relationship with God and to help us connect with the sacrifice that Jesus made for us and the joy that will come because of it on Easter. We will also be celebrating the feast of St. Patrick on March 17 and completing related activities throughout the week.
