Social Studies

This week in Social Studies, students finished 6 which focuses on the aftermath of the American Revolution. Students learned about the Louisiana Purchase as well as Westward Expansion. We also used our imaginations as we completed journal entries based on Lewis & Clark's travels.

Next week, we will complete a project based on chapter 6.

Math

In Math this week we have been busy learning about addition and subtraction of fractions with like and unlike denominators. We learned how to add and subtract mixed numbers, solve fraction word problems, and even began multiplying fractions by whole numbers. Next week we will take a test over Ch. 9.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in Language Arts, students have begun to learn about how to write effective essays and the components of string writing. Be on the lookout for fantastic essays from your child!

Next week, we will continue our work on writing high quality essays.

Religion

This week in Religion we have been focused on Unit 3 Lesson 13. Namely, we have studied the 10 commandments, and were able to separate the commandments that teach us how to love God from the commandments that teach us how to love others. We enjoyed think-pair-share activities that helped us to better understand the commandments. We also studied the precepts of the church to better understand our role and responsibilities as members of the Church starting with the reverence we aim to show God, our families, our friends, and ourselves. We took a guiz today over Unit 3 Lesson 13.

Science

In Science this week we have been learning about what causes changes in weather. We've learned about air masses, fronts, and practiced reading weather maps. We familiarized ourselves with various instruments used to measure weather, and shared aloud our "My Life as a Drip" water cycle narratives. We took a test over Ch. 9 today, and look forward to learning about planets and other objects in space next week when we start Ch. 10.
