Social Studies

We will continue our focus on key figures in the early stages of our nation. Our class will be working on a project in class this week which covers topics like the Great Compromise, federalists, the Virginia Plan, the New Jersey Plan and more.

Math

This week we worked on adding and subtracting unlike fractions and working on simplifying fractions. We will begin working with adding and subtracting mixed numbers.

- *Students will need to complete (mastery level) Khan Academy *Coordinate Plane, Line Plot and Multiply Decimals* by the end of the 3rd quarter. **DUE 3/15**
- * Please practice the basic multiplication facts at home or in the car coming to and from school. Knowing your multiplication facts is a vital skill that students will be needing for success in math in school and in daily life.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we focused on object nouns, short stories in the *Journeys* anthology, and had a test on the spelling/vocabulary words from "James Forten."

Next week, students will focus on theme, using short stories from Journeys, and then we will start reading *The Phantom Tollbooth*. We will also have a quiz on object nouns and will then introduce indirect objects.

Two IRAs (one based on a classic story and one free-choice) are due on Friday, March 17. These will each count as a project grade.

Religion

This week students started studying about the sacraments, and we will continue that next week. They will have a test on this material on Friday, March 17.

Science

We learned about fossils and what they tell us about history. We will begin our weather unit this week.
