Junior Kindergarten

<u>Math</u>

Ms. Wawner's class focused on weight this week and practiced using the words heavy(ier)/light(er). We explored how to use balance scales and practiced weighing object with marbles. Next week, we will be learning about time. Ms. Shank's class explored capacity. The students rotated through centers and explored measuring rice, beans, pasta, and water. We will look at weight next week and have the students weigh themselves.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class focused on the letter J this week. Students jumped rope, sorted and made patterns with jelly beans, and practiced writing their Js. We also practiced the sight word "you" while reviewing our other sight words. Next week, we will learn about the letter Q and learn the sight word "we. Ms. Shank's class worked on the letter Ww this week. Our letter next week will be letter Vv. We continue to look at story elements, (character, setting, problem, and solution). Our sight words will continue to be "like" and "my".

Religious Education

Ms. Wawner's class learned the story of Joseph and his colorful coat. After hearing and reviewing the story, students acted it out and made colorful puppets. Ask them to tell it to you! Next week, we will be learning the story of the Good Samaritan to help students understand compassion, the virtue of the month. This week we focused on the disciples and what makes a disciple. We read the story in Matthew of how Jesus called the disciples to follow him and when Jesus died they continued to spread the word of God. We too can be disciples. We also read the story of Jesus calming the storm. Next week we will be studying St. Patrick and using the shamrock to explain God in three persons, (the Holy

Spirit, God the Father, and God the Son). Our 8th grade faith buddies are going to join us to help with a craft to go with this.

Science/Social Studies

Ms. Wawner's class explored magnets this week. We learned that some things have magnetic fields and how a magnet has a north pole and a south pole. We used magnetic wands to determine whether an object was magnetic or not. Next week, we will start a unit on weather. Ms. Shank's class also explored magnets this week. We will also begin a unit on Weather.
