English Language Arts

This week in grammar we worked on Adverbs, talking about how they answer the questions "where, when, and how" in a sentence. For reading we studied for and began our Charlotte's Web Test. All students completed part 1 and will be working on part 2 for the beginning of next week. We continued on with our cursive focusing on letter connections and word formation. For writing we tweaked and completed out final drafts of our poems about a mask they are making through enrichment with Mrs. Devlin.

Next week we will be finishing our Charlotte's Web test part 2 by March 15th. We will be watching the movie once everyone has finished with the test. We will continue working on adverbs, cursive, and spelling as always next week.

Religion

This week we focused on Lent through the stations. This week we created books to help remind us of the stations. We also read through the passion narrative from the Gospel of Mark. We also used the CRS (Catholic Relief Services) resources to learn about the people that benefit from this charity, focusing on the dignity and rights of workers.

Next week, we will be continuing to talk about Lent, by really focusing on the passion narrative and different events in the Bible about 40 days and by watching daily devotional videos put out by Dynamic Catholic about the "Generosity Habit." (The student's seem to be loving the videos, make sure to ask them what their daily challenge is!)

Math

Next week in math I want to slow down and review multiplication, division, and their relationship through inverse operations. We are gonna use lots of math manipulatives and games to reinforce multiples, multiplication, division, fact families and inverse operations. Please review multiplication facts with students at home or have them use splashlearn or other math websites listed below to review. We have done amazing on multiplication and division thus far, but we need to make those multiplication facts as familiar as possible. The students have been doing a great job learning the relationship between multiplication and division and recognizing the patterns between the two operations.
