Week in Review

Religion

We read a Bible story each day, prayed, and learned about animals in the Bible. We continued reciting the Fruit of the Spirit. We read aloud: What Would Jesus Do in which comprehension strategies were modeled.

Science and Social Studies

Students listened to the story: Dragons Love Tacos and made dragons out of large popsicle sticks. We also learned about the scissor lift which is a mechanical version of what students made.

Students continued working in their famous African Americans books and learned more about Martin Luther King Jr.

Math

We are concluding our unit on Time and Money. Students were challenged to find several ways to make 10, 15, 20, and 25 cents using pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters. Several students received a brag tag for diligence in completing this task. Students also shopped at our classroom store and counted out coins to pay for their items.
