Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We will be learning about westward expansion.

Math

We are continuing to classify quadrilaterals and triangles. We will also be working with numberless word problems.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (<u>khanacademy.org</u>). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 3rd qtr. requirements, **due before the end of the quarter 3/19/24** are Coordinate Plane, Line Plots and Multiplying decimals (under 5th grade - **not** Getting Ready for 5th).

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week students focused on determining a theme in a fictional text. They also continued to work on a second set of homophones and reviewed defining words in context.

Next week, students will have a test on the second set of homophones, and they will have a quiz on determining the theme of a fictional text. We will also start reading *The Phantom Tollbooth*. This is a challenging book, so we will be reading/reviewing each chapter twice, and there will be a reading quiz on many chapters after the second reading. We will also begin studying analogies next week.

Theology

This week we concluded our unit on the structure of the Bible, and next week we will begin a longer unit on the Pentateuch.

Science

We will be learning about fossils and making fossil molds. The big idea will be how we use fossils to understand history and to see how organisms change over time.
