Practice reading page numbers.

Identify patterns.

Measure items in the kitchen or garden.

Week in Review

Religion

Math vocabulary: height, weight, length, capacity, heavier, lighter, holds more, holds less, shorter, taller, longer.

We are practicing short vowel word families. Please have your child read the fluency passages to you five or more times to build reading fluency.
