Student Council presents 2025 Spring Spirit Week! Show your school spirit and earn points for your Spirit Team by dressing up each day. *Please read the guidelines for each day carefully:*

Monday, April 7 - Monochromatic Day
Students may dress in one solid color of their choice. No prints or patterns, no

pajamas, no leggings. Sneakers or school shoes ONLY.

• Tuesday, April 8 - Fun Tie Day

All students can wear any fun tie with your school formal dress uniform (yes, you may wear it to Mass). No ties that light up or make noise.

Social Studies

This Week: Students will learn about life in Ancient Egypt and how it has changed over time. They will complete a map of Egypt showing the changes from ancient to modern time. They will complete a vocabulary foldable activity.

The Unit Test on Ancient Egypt will be Tuesday, March 25th

Next Week: Students will learn about life in Ancient China. We will cover the contributions and how they have influenced our modern world.

Math

This Week: Students will learn strategies on comparing fractions with different numerators and denominators.

Next Week: Students will continue learning how to compare fractions with different numerators and denominators by using models and number lines. They will also be introduced to multiplication by using the strategy of arrays and repeated addition.

This Week:

We kicked off our Persuasive/Opinion Writing Unit and Novel Study/Book Clubs (*Stone Fox*) this week. We also spent time practicing some general reading comprehension and test taking strategies.


