Social Studies

This week in Social Studies, students started a new unit which focuses on the Civil War. Students are currently learning about the key differences between the North and South as well as the causes of the Civil War.

Next week, we will continue this chapter.

Math

In Math this week the kids have enjoyed learning about decimals and ways in which they relate to fractions. We can model decimals through the hundredths place, and will continue Ch. 10 next week. The Ch. 10 Test is scheduled for Tuesday, April 4th.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in Language Arts, students have begun to learn about how to write effective essays and the components of strong writing. Be on the lookout for fantastic essays from your child!

Next week, we will continue our work on writing high quality essays as we move from personal to persuasive essays.

Religion

In Religion this week, the kids have learned about different types of sin and ways in which they separate us from God. We began Unit 3 Lesson 15- "What turns us toward God's love?" Science

This week in Science we took a test over Chapter 10 and worked on our Model of the Solar System and Planet Projects with our groups.
