This week in grammar we reviewed and tested on Adverbs. For reading we started our leveled Novel Study Groups - make sure to ask your student what novel they are reading. We continued on with our cursive focusing on letter connections and word formation.

Next week we will be continuing our small group novel studies. We are continuing on with handwriting and spelling. We will be starting a grammar unit on reviewing and expanding on punctuation and sentence structure. There will not be spelling next week.

### Religion

This week we focused on Lent through looking at the passion narrative in the Bible. We also used the CRS (Catholic Relief Services) resources to learn about the people that benefit from this charity, focusing on the life and dignity of the human person

Next week, we will be continuing reviewing the importance of repentance. We will also pick back up by watching daily devotional videos put out by Dynamic Catholic about the "Generosity Habit." (The student's seem to be loving the videos, make sure to ask them what their daily challenge is!)

### Math

We continue to review, review, revisit, and review multiplication and division. We are still doing independent assessments of multiplication facts in the hallway and all are on their 11's and 9's. Our Multiplication and Division test will be the Friday after we return on April 1st. We will review in class and any review of math multiplication/division facts and word problems at home will help as well. We will focus on reviewing word problems and determining the function needed to solve the problem.
