Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students watched the movie, "Because of Winn Dixie". After watching, we compared/contrasted between the movie and novel and then wrote an opinion essay on which was better.

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students continued Chapter 7 which focuses on the Civil War. Students learned about the Underground Railroad, Abraham Lincoln, and why there was conflict between northern and southern states.

The Ch. 7 Test is currently scheduled for Tuesday, April 5.

Math

This week in Math we learned how to compare and order decimals using models, place value, and a number line. We enjoyed our collaborative learning activity to practice our 4-step problem solving plan, and continued practicing fraction and decimal notation.

Science

This week in Science we have been focused on Matter and its properties. We have been focused on states of matter, and on physical properties of matter like mass, volume, and density. We began a mini-project in which we are scientists who have discovered a "Mystery Matter". Our job is to write a report using physical properties to describe this new substance. Project instructions can be found on Google Classroom.

The Ch. 11 Test is on Friday, April 1st. The Mystery Matter Writing Project is due on Friday, April 1st.

Religion

In Religion this week we had an introduction to the liturgical calendar, and seasons of the Church. We talked about the importance of the Saints, Holy Days of Obligation, and ways we can celebrate Mary and Jesus throughout the Church year. 4A is looking forward to planning Mass on April 1st!
