Add or subtract items in your house or while shopping at the store.

Group and count objects in your house.

Count to 100 by ones, fives, and tens.

Practice reading page numbers.

Identify patterns.

Measure items in the kitchen or garden.

Week in Review

Religion

We read a Bible story each day, prayed, and learned about animals in the Bible. We continued reciting the Fruit of the Spirit. We read aloud from the chapter book: What Would Jesus Do in which comprehension strategies were modeled. -Discussed and completed activities centered around Lent (Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving).

- Mrs. Howard did a special activity related to the story of Jesus calming the storm.

Science and Social Studies

Math

We continued our unit on measurement and used the balance scales to compare weights. Math vocabulary: height, weight, length, capacity, heavier, lighter, holds more, holds less, shorter, taller, longer.

Language Arts

Please continue to practice sight words at home. We continued the next level of sight words. Each morning students read 10 review words as they come in the door.

We are practicing short vowel word families. Please have your child read the fluency passages to you five or more times to build reading fluency.
