Subtraction sweethearts! We kicked off a unit on subtraction this week with lessons focused on fact families, subtraction without regrouping, and identifying when and how to regroup. Fact fluency is key to computation...please help your Sloth or Cheetah maintain momentum with his/her math facts by practicing DAILY (flashcards, orally, worksheets, dice, playing cards, etc.).

Literacy

Descriptive, delightful, and adorable! Our unit on adjectives is breathing new life into our writing! From adjectives that compare (-er and -est) to the use of articles, the Sloths and Cheetahs are taking it all in!

New word lists will be instructed and tested next week. Please remind your Sloth or Cheetah to complete activities from the <u>homework menu</u>. We'll be working with "bonus" words to help transfer learned spelling features to unfamiliar words and to writing in context.

Awesome authors! The Sloths and Cheetahs enjoy writing both fiction and non-fiction pieces to share with one another from the author's chair. It's exciting to see our sweet storytellers putting into practice learned grammar, capitalization, and punctuation.

The Sloths and Cheetahs are devouring books! Our reading recipe includes, but is not limited to Roald Dahl read alouds (in preparation for his upcoming birthday bash), science/social studies nonfiction comprehension texts, novel studies, sight words, fluency passages, and decodable word work. Our radiant readers are definitely diligent!

This week, our little theologians were as curious as could be as we started our new chapter on how we praise and thank God! Both cheetahs and sloths alike are so thoughtful and insightful with their questions about the faith. Next week, we will continue our new chapter and learn that our Mass is the same everywhere around the world!


Science/Social Studies



Using cornmeal and "rainmakers," our excellent experimenters observed first-hand how erosion impacts landforms. Seeing the negative repercussions of erosion, our excellent engineers were challenged to use cotton balls, toothpicks, and aluminum foil to prevent erosion on "cornmeal mountains."
