Social Studies

This week in Social Studies, students began continued 6 which focuses on the aftermath of the American Revolution. Students learned about important historical figures such as George Washington and James Madison. Students also learned about the Constitution and the Bill of Rights!

Next week, we will continue this chapter. The ch. 6 test is scheduled for Thursday, March 9.

Math

This week in Math we have been engaged reviewing all things fractions. We have been practicing our skills with simplifying, comparing, ordering, and generating equivalent fractions, and enjoyed an "I have who has" game reviewing mixed numbers to improper fraction conversions. We took our test over Ch. 8 and began Ch. 9 on fraction operations. So far we have learned how to add and subtract fractions with common denominators.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in Language Arts, students finished *Because of Winn Dixie* as well as a writing unit in which we focused on how to write realistic fiction stories. Students learned how to write powerful endings as well as how to draft their stories. These stories are really coming along and students are putting in a ton of effort!

Next week, we will begin a new writing unit that focuses on writing well crafted essays.

Religion

In Religion this week we have been focused on Unit 3 Lesson 12. We put gifts from the Holy Spirit into our own words, learned the importance of the Theological Virtues of Faith, Hope, and Charity, and put the Beatitudes into action as we each strive to live as Jesus' disciples. Next week will begin Unit 3 Lesson 13; "How Does God teach us to love?" Passion Play costume pieces have been distributed. Please see "Passion Play Costume Information" email sent yesterday.

The Unit 3 Lesson 13 Religion quiz is scheduled for Friday, March 10th.

Science

In Science this week we have had some fun learning about the Water Cycle and how it is related to weather. We illustrated ways rain, snow, sleet and hail form as a performance assessment, and finished our water cycle narrative "My Life as a Drip". We look forward to sharing these next week. We are continuing to learn about sea breezes/land breezes, the rain shadow effect, air masses, fronts, cloud systems, and ways we can measure weather patterns.

The Ch. 9 Science test is scheduled for Friday, March 10th.
