#### **Social Studies**

This week in Social Studies, students continued a unit which focuses on the Civil War. Students learned about the men who led during the war and specific battles as well. This is a very engaging unit that students have thoroughly enjoyed!

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in Language Arts, students worked on the rough drafts of their persuasive essays. We also started a new novel, *Some Places More Than Others*, in which students will learn about family history and will lead us to our big end of year project! Next week, we will continue this novel and workmon our summarizing skills.

The final draft of the persuasive essay is due on Monday, April 3. This is to be handwritten in cursive.

# Religion

In Religion this week, we have been focused on Unit 3 Lesson 15- "What turns us toward God's love?". We learned about sanctifying grace, distinguished between wants vs. needs, wrote an acrostic poem for the word "holy" and wrote individual prayers for strength and grace for specific things we need in the coming weeks. The students began writing conversion stories/comics, and we had two successful Passion Play rehearsals. I am so proud of their hard work! It's going to be a great show. The Unit 3 Test is scheduled for Tuesday, April 4. Conversion stories are due Wednesday, April 5.
