## **Social Studies**

**This Week:** Students are learning about Ancient Egypt and the importance of the Nile River, hieroglyphics, architecture, and inventions and how these contributions influenced our modern society.

**Next Week:** Students will learn about life in Ancient Egypt and how it has changed over time. They will complete a cause and effect activity and a map of Egypt showing the changes from ancient to modern time. They will complete a vocabulary foldable activity.

## Math

**This Week:** Students will learn how to represent equivalent fractions on a number line and review the strategies of using models and fraction tiles to determine equivalent fractions.

**Next Week:** Students will learn how to compare fractions with similar numerators and denominators. They will also compare fractions which are greater than, less than, or equal to one another.
