Social Studies

This week students will learn about the invention of Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs, papyrus, and architecture.

Next week students will learn why water clocks and the calendar were invented. They will discover how they were used in ancient times. They will explore how the geography of Ancient Egypt had a big impact on its peoples lives and how Egypt has changed in size over time.

Math

This week students will learn about the relationship between multiplication and division. They will be introduced to the vocabulary associated with the process of division.

Next week students will use strategies such as drawing models, multiples, numbers lines, and repeated subtraction to solve division problems. They will also learn how to use inverse operation and fact families for multiplication and division.

Theology

This Week:

We continued focusing our attention on Lent, thus, preparing for the great sacrifice that Jesus will make for us, growing closer to God, and asking him for forgiveness. We completed activities that draw upon the Lenten disciplines of prayer, almsgiving, and fasting/abstinence. We also learned how we can celebrate Jesus' forgiveness and healing in the Church through the sacraments of Penance and Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick.

Next Week:

Continued from last week, we will be working through our Theology of the Body curriculum (Lesson 3 - Sin Distorts the Gift). Students will learn that sin is a failure to love, will recognize that sin distorts our ability to recognize the gifts of God, and will identify ways to reconcile relationships between people and God. We will also be learning about St. Patrick and working in our Christ In Us workbook (Lesson 10 - How are we strengthened for service to God and others?). - Quiz - Fri 3/15

Science

This week students will learn about the physical properties of solids, liquids, and gas. They will also begin learning vocabulary associated with our matter unit.

Next week students will learn about the properties of mass, volume, and density through our experiments. They will discover how heat energy can change the phases of matter.
