Week in Review Language Arts In Language Arts this week, students learned how to move from opinion writing to persuasive writing. Don't be surprised if their persuasive skills have dramatically improved! Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students continued Chapter 7 which focuses on the Civil War. Students learned about historical figures such as Thomas "Stonewall" Jackson, Ulysses Grant, and Robert Lee.
