Math

This week we finished our unit on data analysis. We focused on understanding how to read and answer questions using line plots, picture graphs and bar graphs. Next week we will review previous taught skills: number sense, problem solving, measurement and geometry.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Reading

This week we focused on fractured fairy tales. We had multiple fractured fairy tale reader's theater scripts that the students read aloud. This type of reading helped our students build reading fluency and gain an understanding of how to create their own script. Next week our focus will be on poetry.

<u>Grammar</u>

This week we focused on types of sentences. Next week we will learn about some elements of poetry: alliteration and onomatopoeia.

Writing

In writing students worked in groups to write their own fractured fairy tale skit. Next week we will write and explore different types of poetry.

Theology

This week we learned about the sacraments, vessels used during the Mass and the Eucharist in order to prepare for first communion. We also were able to meet outside with our faith buddies and walked the stations of the cross.

Social Studies

We focused on science this week.

Science

We started our unit on animal and plant life cycles. Next week we will choose an animal to research and we will create a clay sculpture of our animal in the STEM lab.
