Theology

This Week:

We continued our Lenten Journey this week by reading from our daily Devotional book, completing activities that highlight the promises that we are making during this time (fasting, almsgiving, and prayer), and making connections within our Christ In Us discussions and readings. We also had our Second Lesson from the Empowering God's Children program and began preparing for 3rd Grade's Mass coming up after the break.

"I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen."

As Easter approaches, Paul states in Romans 6 that baptism symbolises our dying with Christ and our being raised to new life in him. Thus, memorizing the Apostles' Creed, or Baptismal Creed, helps children to develop a deeper understanding of the Christian faith and provides a basic outline of belief that those being baptized would need to understand. By committing the words to memory, they can internalize the beliefs and principles that the creed expresses. This can lead to a stronger sense of personal faith and a better understanding of what it means to be a Christian. It can also help to build a foundation for future Bible study.

The creed is divided into three sections. The first section affirms the belief in God the Father, the Creator of heaven and earth. The second section affirms belief in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, and his life, death, and resurrection. The third section affirms belief in the Holy Spirit, the Church, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.

Science

This Week: Students will learn how to measure mass using the metric system and the tools needed to measure different types of solids. They will be using a balance scale to measure the mass of different objects. The will be introduced to density and volume and how it relates to a solid, liquid and gas.

Next Week: Students will be comparing the density and volume of different objects. They will also learn how temperature can cause changes to the states of matter, as well as how certain types of matter can become a mixture or a solution.


