### **Social Studies**

This week in SS, students participated in creating a timeline of the Civil War. This was a really engaging project in which students had to research further and decide what they felt were the 5 most important events of the Civil War. Students will present their final drafts next week.

#### Math

This week in Math, we learned the formulas for Area and Perimeter. We also started a project highlighting these concepts. Next week, we will continue to work on the project.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students began a new novel, *Some Places More Than Others*. This is a wonderful story about family, identity, forgiveness, and so much more. We are continuing to study story elements as students begin wrapping up the books that they are writing themselves! We will continue this work next week.

## Theology

This week in Theology, we completed two chapters in our Christ in Us book and had a quiz. We also practiced for the Passion play.

#### Science

This week in Science, we wrapped up our unit on Force and Motion. We also did an experiment where students practiced writing a hypothesis and collecting data on friction.

Next Wednesday April 16th, we will have our test for this unit. Students are bringing their notebooks home along with a list of things to study in preparation.






























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
