Social Studies

We focused on science this week.

Math

We are reviewing addition and subtraction. The students are continuing to practice the name and value of a penny, nickel, dime, quarter and half dollar. We also continued to practice counting to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. At this time, the students are now expected to count to 100. The students have also been counting to 100 by 2s, 5s and 10s. We have calendar time during math every day.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

The students are continuing to practice reading to self and work on writing. Please have your child read the books and reading comprehension packets sent home every Friday to you three times to practice sight words and fluency. **Our sight words this week were: one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten. Our sight words for next week are: would,very, your,its, around.**

Theology

We learned more about the season of Lent and recited prayers for Lent. We will be participating in the stations of the cross in the chapel or outside every Friday during Lent. Next Tuesday, we will be doing the stations of the cross with our faith buddies.

Science

We continued to speak about living and nonliving things and what plants need to live. Also, the students made an Earth day project.
