## **Teacher Announcements:**

We can hardly believe the year is moving so quickly and spring break has arrived! We wish each of our students and their families a blessed Holy Week and a very Happy

**Easter!** We hope you enjoy the Resurrection Eggs students brought home with them over the break. To enjoy this activity as it was originally intended, grab your favorite version of the account of the Passion of Our Lord and read it with your child, opening the eggs along the way as you read. The book we read this Holy Thursday was *The Easter Story* by Brian Wildsmith, but the items can be adapted to different versions. Here is a list of the items found inside the eggs:

- 1 Donkey Jesus arrives in Jerusalem riding a donkey on Palm Sunday
- 2 Coin Jesus discovers the money lenders in the temple and expels them
- 3 Cracker Jesus joins his friends for the Passover meal, the first celebration of the Eucharist and His Last Supper
- 4 Leaves The agony of Jesus in the garden of Gethsemane
- 5 Whip Jesus is arrested and scourged
- 6 Thorn Jesus is given a crown of thorns to wear on His head
- 7 Cross Jesus carries the cross
- 8 Nail Jesus is crucified
- 9 Die The soldiers gamble for Jesus' garments
- 10 White linen Jesus is wrapped in white linen after being taken down from the cross
- 11 Stone the stone covers the tomb where His body lays
- 12 This egg is empty because...the tomb is empty! He is Risen!

We hope they will be a gift to your family and a Holy Week tradition in the years to come!
