Science/Social Studies

Ms. Wawner began a unit on insects. We started by brainstorming all the insects we know and thought about things they have in common. We have learned that insects all have a 3-part body, 6 legs, antennae, and an exoskeleton. We also brainstormed ideas about where insects live and what they eat. At the end of the week, we focused on ladybugs. We labeled the parts of a ladybug and created an art project featuring them. Next week we will learn about an insect's life cycle. Ms. Shank's class started our unit on weather and Spring. We learned about different cloud types and what weather you would find associated with that cloud type. We are also incorporating that into our daily weather forecast. Whoever is the calendar helper for that day needs to tell what cloud type and what weather. We completed an experiment called rain in a glass. We are also going to be learning about the water cycle and each child will create the water cycle in a bag. Next week we will learn about instruments that help us determine concepts of weather. We will make windsocks, anemometer to determine the strength of the wind, and learn about extreme weather.

Math

Ms. Wawner's class continued to practice addition this week. Students are able to count a group of one thing and then count a group of another and come up with the sum. We are using manipulatives, part/part/whole mats, stations with games, and worksheets to practice this concept. Ms. Shank's class continues to work on the concept of addition being a part-part-whole. We may begin subtraction next week. I have begun assessing students regarding their number sense. Copies will be sent home.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class focused on the letter Y this week. We read the book Extra Yarn and talked about the characters, setting, and plot (the who, where, what of a story). We created sweaters made of extra yarn and students came up with who they would give it to you and why. We practiced the sight word "in." Instead of memorizing these words, we are working on decoding them by breaking them apart into sounds. We continue our author study of Eric Carle. Ms. Shank's class worked on writing a new story about Hoppy the rabbit and his friend Duck. We also worked on the letter Zz. In some reading groups we are learning about word families. Other groups are still working on letter sound. Next week we will finish our study of the alphabet with the letter Q. I am currently assessing letter and sound knowledge. I will be sending these home as well.

Theology

Ms. Wawner talked about different ways we can take care of our earth. Ms. Shank's class learned about certain saints who were visited by Mary.

- Immunization and School Entrance Health Forms

Students enrolling in Kindergarten need to have a Commonwealth of Virginia School Entrance Health form. Physicals, including updated immunizations, must have been on or after August 20th, 2023. Please submit the entire document. This form should not require an additional doctor's visit if they have been seen within this time frame. Many doctor's offices get busy over the summer with form requests, please ask for this as soon as possible. Your child CAN NOT attend school until these papers are provided and are reviewed by the school nurse. Feel free to start sending them in from now.
