Social Studies

This week students learned the routes of the Silk Roads and Chinese Numbers. They completed a map indicating the changes in size from the past to present day. Study guides will go home in their Friday Folder. The unit test will be scheduled for next Thursday.

Next week students will be introduced to Life in Ancient Greece. We will begin with the contributions of architecture, government and sports.

Math

This week students will learn to multiply by 3, 4, and 6. They will be introduced to the strategy of using the distributive property of multiplication to decompose a factor in the multiplication sentence.

Next week students will learn the multiples as a strategy for multiplying by 7, 8, and 9. They will also be introduced to the associative property of multiplication.

This Week:

We had several important discussions around our read aloud book for the week, *I Dissent: Ruth Bader Ginsburg Makes Her Mark*. This book highlighted Ginsbug's early life and inspiration, the unfair prejudice and stereotypes that she was confronted with because she was a woman, a mother, and Jewish, and her pursuit of creating equality for all. This book also helped to reinforce prefixes (re, un, pre, dis), which coincided with our Word Study for the week.

Theology

This Week:

We completed our Christ In Us workbook (Unit 3, Lesson 12 - How do we respond to God's love?), learned more about the Beatitudes, which are the teachings of Jesus that describe the way to live in God's happiness, discussed our tenant of the month for April (Achievers), and completed a lesson from our Theology of the Body curriculum (Focus: Body-Soul Unity).

Next Week:

Beginning on Thursday, May 2nd we will pray the rosary weekly (Thursdays at 8:15) in honor of May being the month devoted to Mary. We will also complete the next lesson from our Theology of the Body curriculum (Focus: Gift of Self) and continue to work through our Christ In Us workbook (Unit 3, Lesson 13 - How does God teach us to love?). Science

This week students will learn about matter's physical properties of mass, volume, and density through our experiments. They will also be introduced to how temperature affects matter and describe the process of evaporation and condensation.

Next week students will learn about how a chemical change is different from a physical change through learning about mixtures and solutions. They will complete a study guide on the properties of matter.
