Social Studies

Students say prayers and the Pledge of Allegiance each day. We focused on science this week.

Math

Students are reviewing two dimensional shapes as well as coins. The students have also been enjoying centers which include work with a teacher, using math manipulatives to review certain skills, math binders and math games. The students are enjoying and practicing a lot of skills during math. We are also having the students recognize coins and telling time to the hour.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

We continued fluency passages. Each passage focuses on a particular word family, consonant blend, or digraph. Please have your child read these passages to you at home.

Theology

During Theology this week, we started a chapter book called What Would Jesus Do? We also reviewed a book called Blueberries for Sal and talked about the differences and similarities of each of the four characters. The students talked about what kind of work Sal did as well as the baby bear. We also spoke about who in our school does a lot of hard work and drew a picture of them. Then, we gave out our papers to those people.

Science

We talked about living and non living things. Then, the students circled the objects that are living.
