Social Studies

Last week we learned about how the government dealt with the Native Americans. We will begin our focus on the Industrial Revolution.

Math

We will continue this week on learning about measurement and will be working with conversions.

- *Students will need to complete (mastery level) Khan Academy *Add and Subtract Fractions, Multiplying Fractions, and Algebraic Thinking* by the end of the 4th quarter.
- * Please practice the basic multiplication facts at home or in the car coming to and from school. Knowing your multiplication facts is a vital skill that students will be needing for success in math in school and in daily life.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week students took a test on the first part of *The Phantom Tollbooth*. They also had a test on grammar lessons VIE 1.9, 1.10, and 1.11, and one on the spelling/vocabulary words from chapters 6-9 of *The Phantom Tollbooth*. They also were introduced to a writing project connected to the novel.

Next week, we will continue reading *The Phantom Tollbooth*, receive a new list of spelling/vocabulary words, and focus heavily on the writing project based on the novel.

Religion

This week students continued our unit on The Beatitudes. They focused on the meaning of the first three, and they are working on a unit-long project that will be due at the end of the unit in approximately two weeks. They will also start memorizing The Beatitudes and will have a recitation quiz on the first four at the end of next week, and a test on all of them when we complete the unit.

Science

We have been learning about stars, seasons, and day and night. This week we will be learning about the moon and centripetal force.
