English Language Arts

This week in grammar we wrapped up reviewing and taking a deeper dive into capitalization and punctuation. For reading comprehension review this week we tried a new type of reading check. For reading we continued our leveled Novel Study Groups, through finishing our books.

Next week we will be testing on capitalization and punctuation on May 3rd (Tuesday), study guides will be in Friday Folders. We will also be continuing with paragraphs of the week, focusing on informational writing. We will continue on with our reading checks, spelling, and reviewing handwriting. For Novel Studies we will be working on reviewing for our Novel Study tests that will take place from Wednesday the 4th - Friday the 6th. This test will be very similar to the Charlotte's Web test where students will tell main events and characters, then create a poster for the book.

Religion

This week we talked about Easter - as the season of Easter lasts through Pentecost - June 5th. We also continued our discussion about Prayer that we started before Lent.

Next week we will be wrapping up our unit on prayer and starting our review. The test will be on Tuesday May 10th - Study guides will come home next week. On Wednesday, May 5th we will be doing our 2nd Protecting God's Children Lesson focused on Safe Adults and Special Safe Adults. Special Safe Adults are people such as parents and doctors. If you have any questions please let Mrs. Kelliher know.

Math

This week we are reviewing the properties of multiplication and division. We will use a variety of methods to organize and solve multiplication and division sentences. Students will be introduced to fractions beginning with identifying equal parts.

Students will bring home their Math Book Volume 1to complete pages we skipped for practice during the summer months to help prepare them for fourth grade.

This week we will be introduced to the three phases of Matter and how they can be changed through the use of energy. Students will learn how energy can be used to change the phases of matter and why it is important to us as a resource. We will begin working on our vocabulary foldable books and conduct an experiment on the properties of a liquid.
