Social Studies

This week in Social Studies, students finished and tested over our unit which focused on the Civil War. We will complete a project over the Civil War upon our return from Easter Break!

Math

This week in Math, the kids took a test over Ch. 10 on decimals and fractions through the hundredths place. I was overjoyed to see how many students took to decimals as a topic of interest. We will begin our study of Customary Units of Length in Ch. 11 when we return from break. Please ensure your child has a ruler with both inches and centimeters by Monday, April 17th.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in Language Arts, students continued our new novel, *Some Places More Than Others*. This is a wonderful story in which students will learn about family history and will lead us to our big end of year project! We will continue this story upon our return to school after Easter Break!

Religion

In Religion this week, the kids took a test over Unit 3- "How do we live what we believe?". We finished and shared our conversion stories. We also had the opportunity to "judge" the 8th grade Church projects. The kids were in awe over how much time and effort was put into these. They're already looking forward to the project themselves. When we return from break, we will begin Unit 4- "How do we become what we believe?" We will be focused on Unit 4 Lesson 16- "What is prayer?"

Science

In Science this week, we finished presenting our Planet projects. We began Ch. 11 and have transitioned from earth science to physical science. We are learning all about matter, mass, volume, density, physical properties of matter, and states of matter. We began a "mystery matter" mini-project in which the kids are scientists who have discovered a mystery substance, and are required to describe this new discovery with a variety of physical properties in a detailed report with an illustration. The Ch. 11 test, and "Mystery Matter" writing assignment will be due the week we return to school. The kids are absolutely loving the assignment!
