Week in Review

Language Arts-

In Language Arts this week, students began "Some Places More Than Others". This is the most complex story that we have read so far. The students are thoroughly engaged and enjoying the book as well as the conversations that take place in class!

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students finished Chapter 7 which focuses on the Civil War.

Math

In Math this week we have enjoyed learning about customary units of weight and time. We learned how to display measurement data on a line plot and have been working to solve measurement word problems related to customary units of length, capacity, weight and time.

The Chapter 11 Math test is scheduled for Wednesday, April 13th.

Science

In Science this week we have continued learning about Matter. We have enjoyed sharing our Mystery Matter projects, and are applying our knowledge of physical properties to atoms, elements and compounds. We are learning about physical vs. chemical properties, changes, and reactions and look forward to our in-class test review activities next week.

The Chapter 12 Science test is scheduled for Wednesday, April 13th.

Religion

In Religion this week we have been focused on the meaning of the liturgical season of Christmas. We read and reflected on the Nativity story in our Bibles, and enjoyed a Christmas prayer ritual encompassing the theme of Peace. Each of us wrote a prayer for Peace which we brought forth to the ritual. This week we also had the opportunity to lead our First Grade faith buddies in the outdoor Stations of the Cross.
